Position Announcement
Offsite Cook and Meals on Wheels Delivery - Boulder

Rocky Mountain Development Council, Inc.'s (Rocky) Senior Nutrition Program is currently seeking applicants for an Off-Site Cook and Meals on Wheels Delivery in Boulder. This position is 21 hours per week, working Tuesday – Thursday, typically 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The starting salary for this position is \$10.95 per hour.

The Offsite Cook is responsible for the ordering and preparation of food, record keeping, sanitation, Meals on Wheels delivery, and commodity program paperwork.

Minimum Qualifications:

Knowledge: Must have knowledge in all phases of food preparation, sanitation, inventory control and cost control. Proficient knowledge of Microsoft Office products and skilled using general office machines (computer, fax, copier, scanner, etc.).

Abilities: Ability to cook quantities of food for up to 25 people, prepare menus and work prolonged hours while standing. Ability to maintain an effective working relationship with clients. Ability to follow instructions and communicate effectively verbally and in writing. Ability to organize and manage time, and take initiative. Ability to lift 50 pounds.

The above knowledge and abilities are typically acquired through a combination of education and experience equivalent to a high school education and three years of experience cooking in quantity for a commercial or institutional food operation. Must obtain and maintain Servsafe Food Safety Certification. A valid Montana driver's license, reliable personal transportation, liability insurance and good driver's record is required. Applicant must be approved as a driver by Rocky's insurance carrier. Experience working with senior citizens is preferred.

OR EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

Physical Demands & Working Conditions: Ability to work prolonged hours while standing. Ability to lift 50 pounds. Ability to drive and be outdoors in severe weather conditions.
